Safe Passage Monthly Update: January



2017 Overview

*In 2017 alone, Safe Passage provided over **17,000 hours** of support to survivors. **57** adults and **52** children found a safe place to stay in a crisis as Safe Passage provided nearly **8,000** nights of emergency shelter. Survivors found safety and support navigating the legal system. Our legal advocates helped clients successfully petition for **140** Orders of Protection. Nearly **4800** calls came into our 24-hour crisis hotline, allowing staff to offer crisis intervention, information and support for survivors at any time of the day or night.*
